Performance Season Classes

Registration Fee

There is a \$50 Registration Fee (per family) charged upon registration. This fee is non-refundable.

Tuition

Our tuition fees are based on weekly hours accumulated by each dancer on a 28-week season. Tuition has been divided into 8 equal payments that will be billed monthly. These payments will be billed on the 1st of the month September - April, and are due upon receipt.

Families who prefer to pay in full before September 30th will receive a 10% discount. Please note that it may take some days for us to get back to you.

Additional Fees

COSTUME FEES - \$100 for Performance Classes – billed October 1, due October 15th
Costume Fees are non-refundable.

FESTIVAL FEES - \$150 for each Performance Class - billed November 1st, due November 15th
Festival Fees are non-refundable.

All regular Performance Classes will be attending 3 festivals in the spring. Sessional Classes (such as Little Minis and Intro to Acro) are not included in this fee schedule.
